# DESIGN UPDATE ON RELEASE 1.2 AND RELEASE 1.3

# RELEASE 1.2 AND RELEASE 1.3

- We are in the final phases of completing the design of the solution for Release 1.2 and Release 1.3
- So far, there have been no surprises in the design
- We are now seeing elements of the design come to life, for example the Self Service Interface (SSI)
- We are continuing our schedule of monthly Design Release Forums to keep Users informed of progress and any changes that may impact User systems

# RELEASE 1.2 AND RELEASE 1.3

## Release 1.3 - Service Request Variants by Release Candidate

- In the Service Request Variants by Release Candidate shared as part of the Release candidate submission in the contingency request, DCC User Interface Specification (DUIS) Service Request variant 8.5 – “ServiceOptOut” was incorrectly assigned to a Release
- It was stated as being available in the 1.1 release and all subsequent releases, but on further confirmation and alignment with our Service Providers this Service Request Variant is confirmed as currently planned for delivery as part of the 1.3 release
- DCC have therefore made a formal request to DECC to update the Service Request Variants by Release to update DUIS Service Request variant 8.5 – “ServiceOptOut” to show as being available from the 1.3 release onwards instead of the current document 1.1 release
- All other Service Request Variants have been confirmed as being corrected allocated to Release

# RELEASE CANDIDATE RC1.4

- As part of our Release 1.Xs strategy, we are in the early stages of the next potential release candidate RC1.4
- RC1.4 is being considered as a contingency release candidate and may or may not be called into action
- RC1.4 may include urgent changes or defect corrections from previous releases.
- There is NO content currently defined for RC1.4, it is a placeholder only
- Information on any proposed content for RC1.4 will be shared with Users as and when proposals are made to use this contingency release candidate.

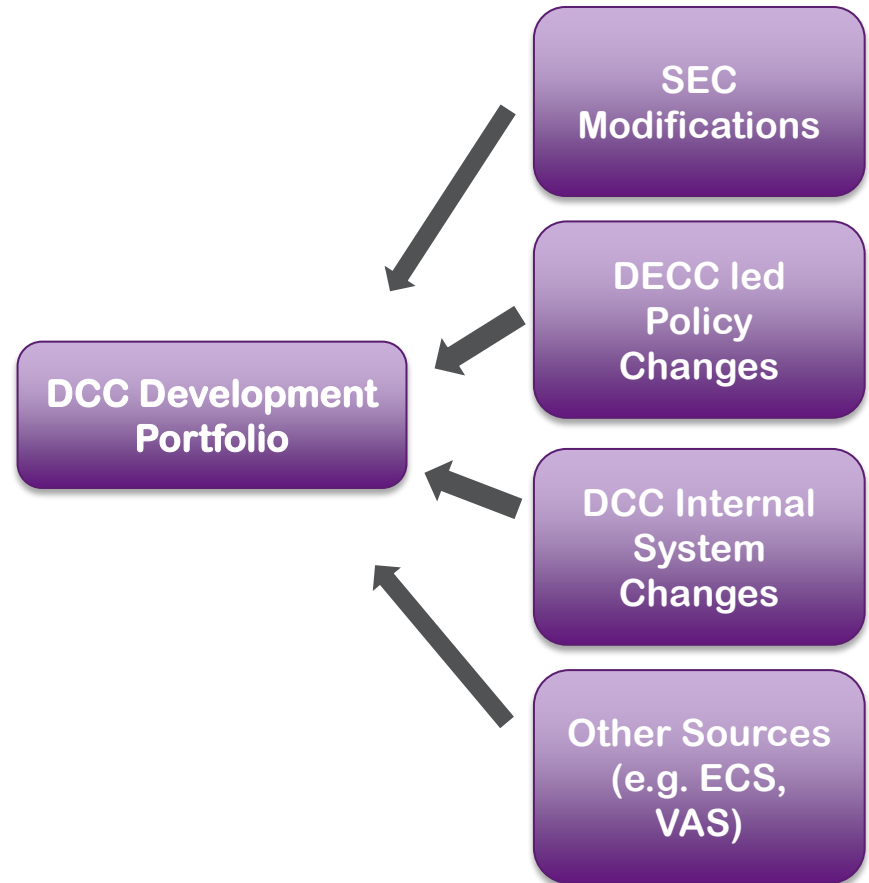




# FUTURE CHANGE

- **Change to the Smart Energy Code, the SEC Subsidiary Documents and to the DCC systems continues to be identified**
- **To deliver the system impacting change, we are looking forwards to Release Candidate 2.0 and beyond**
- **There are many sources of change, which we assess and manage through our future change portfolio**



# RELEASE CANDIDATE RC2.0

- **We are working with SECAS and DECC to put forward a proposed scope for R2.0 while taking into account mandatory regulatory change**
- **As part of proposing the scope of RC2.0, we will also provide an indicative timeline for delivery**
- **We aim to begin talking to Parties about the proposed scope today and through our various stakeholder and governance groups over the next few months**
- **We require direction from the Secretary of State to formally begin work on RC2.0**
